Joan Maria Nin Génova is appointed non-executive chairman of MoraBanc in April 2021 to provide further impetus to the bank's corporate governance with his long experience in the banking sector and on boards of directors in a range of sectors.

He began his extensive career as programme director for the Spanish Minister's team for Relations with the European Economic Community (1978-1980) and was part of the negotiations for Spain's accession to the Common Market. He has been General Manager of Santander Central Hispano (1980-2002), CEO (Chief Executive Officer) of Banco Sabadell (2002-2007), Managing Director of La Caixa (2007-2011) and Vice-President and CEO of CaixaBank, Critería and La Caixa Foundation (2011-2014). He is a former chairman of the Fundación Consejo España-Estados Unidos and is currently a member of several boards of directors including Société Générale, the European Advisory Board of Service Now, the Dutch consulting firm Metyis, Itinere Infrastructures and the property development company Promociones Habitat. He currently serves as chairman of the boards of the latter two companies, and is the vice-chairman of the Círculo de Empresarios.

Born in Barcelona in 1953, Nin is a lawyer and holds a degree in economics from the University of Deusto and a Master's degree in Law from the London School of Economics and Political Sciences. He is the author of several highly regarded publications, a renowned analyst of the complexities of international relations, economics and politics, as well as a leading expert on banking, business transformation processes and European politics.
